

## 2019 Fulbright Visiting Scholar Program

### **Application Now Open!**

The U.S. Embassy in Baghdad is pleased to announce the opening of the Fulbright Visiting Scholar Program competition for 2019. Sponsored by the U.S. Department of State, this program is a ten-week non-degree professional and faculty development program to send to the U.S. 25 junior Iraqi scholars. Grantees will be selected from the following disciplines: Business Administration and Economics, Engineering, Science and Technology, and TEFL/Linguistics.

### Fulbright Visiting Scholar Grants Provide Funding for:

- A stipend that will be distributed upon arrival to the United States,
- Travel allowance,
- Professional development funds,
- Round-trip airfare from Iraq to the United States,
- Accident and sickness medical coverage,
- Furnished, apartment-style accommodations.

### Who is Eligible to Apply?

- Applicants must be Iraqi citizens, currently resident in Iraq, and committed to returning there upon completion of the grant.
- Demonstrate a commitment to classroom teaching and a desire to strengthen teaching and leadership skills.
- Scholar's academic focus must be in one of the program's offered academic discipline cohorts.
- Applicants must be able to travel to and remain in the U.S. during the dedicated grant period of June through September 2019.
- Eligible candidates should possess a high proficiency in written and oral English (recommended minimum TOEFL score of 500).
- Applicants must not have applied or be planning to apply for a U.S. green card or asylum status. Applicants cannot be dual citizens of the U.S. and Iraq.
- Applicants must be a full-time Iraqi university faculty member who possess, at a minimum, a master's degree and at least three years of university-level teaching experience or a Ph.D. and no more than seven years of teaching experience.

### The Application Process:

- Applications for this program are to be submitted online

- In addition to the application form, supporting documents such as 3 letters of recommendation, a C.V., a study

- plan, and a scanned copy of passport biographical page (if available) need to be uploaded and submitted with the online application form.
